
Please bring your appointment letter and Audiology passport with you to the appointment. Please hand these in at reception when you arrive.



It is important that you have your hearing tested so any problems can be treated. If you struggle to hear family and friends we can help you to hear better.

**You will be seen by an Audiologist. Your Audiologists name is:**

The hearing test will be done in a soundproof room with no windows. This is to make sure we get accurate results. The test can take up to 30 minutes.



**Your Audiologist will look in your ears. This may tickle but should not hurt:**



**Your Audiologist will put some headphones over your ears:**



**When you hear a sound you may be asked to press a button or play a game:**



When the test is finished, your Audiologist may look in your ears again.

Your Audiologist will give you the results of the hearing test and together you will decide what treatment is needed next.
