Family Hubs will offer the right help, in the right place, at the right time by offering services and support for all families in Sandwell with children aged 0 – 19 (or 25 with SEND). As one of the lead providers of Family Hubs, Barnardo's aim to ensure every element of their services is accessible for all families and offer specific SEND support, including:

Cygnet

Cygnet is Barnardo's 7 week programme for parents/carers of autistic children or children who are on the pathway to be assessed for autism. There is a Parent/Carer Drop in where you can ask any of those niggling questions, reach out for support or ask for support in accessing wider services. Week 7 is supported by CAMHS, AWM and SENDIASS to share information with parents/carers on different support avenues.

Stepping Stones

This is an 8 week programme which supports parents or caregivers of children aged 0 to 12 with a developmental disability.

Solihull Approach

This is a 10 week programme which focuses on containment, reciprocity and behaviour management.
